- ⇒ NO SHOUTING OR SCREAMING



Swimming pool and wet area supervision

- * These facilities are not supervised whilst in use. Regular checks are made of the facility by nominated staff which will advise and assist customers as may be necessary.
- * Children under the age of 16 are to be supervised at all times by a responsible person over the age of 16.
- * The responsible person over the age of 16 may supervise a **maximum** of 2 children under the age of 16.
- * Children under the age of 4 must be supervised on a one to one basis.
- * Children under the age of 16 years must be supervised by their parents or responsible adult who must be present with the children at all times.
- * Our maximum bathing load is recommended to have 28 bathers at any time.

INFLATABLES

Swimming pools attract bathers with inflatable toys; although fun for users they create blind spots, encourage risk taking and dangerous activities, let alone inconvenience to others.

It is therefore recommended that inflatables are not allowed unless they are recognised swimming aids.

Clothing and Equipment

The following ARE PERMITTED to be worn or used by customers :

Clothing:

- √ Swimsuits
- √ Bikinis
- √ Swimming shorts/trunks

With the permission of the owner or an appropriate person, 'T shirts' may be worn to cover medical conditions.

Equipment

- √ Swimming goggles
- √ Buoyancy aids (arm bands, swim rings and floaters)
- √ Hand paddles

We do not loan equipment and buoyancy aids to members of the public!

The following ARE NOT PERMITTED to be worn or used by customers :

Clothing:

- × Underwear
- × Denim/ cut down jeans
- × Non swimming shorts
- × Infants or babies not wearing nappies

Equipment:

- × Face masks
- × Snorkels
- × Fin/ flippers
- × Inflatable boats
- × Body boards



General rules



- ◆ No children will be allowed under the age of 16 unless accompanied by an adult.
- ◆ Customers will not be allowed to use the facilities whilst under the influence of alcohol.
- ◆ Customers are advised to allow 1 hour for the digestion of food before using the pool.
- ◆ Swimmers who use the pool as lone bathers do so at their own risk.
- ◆ Customers are respectfully advised to follow the signs provided for their own safety.
- ◆ Customers must wear shoes/flip flops or sandals to walk across to the toilet.
